

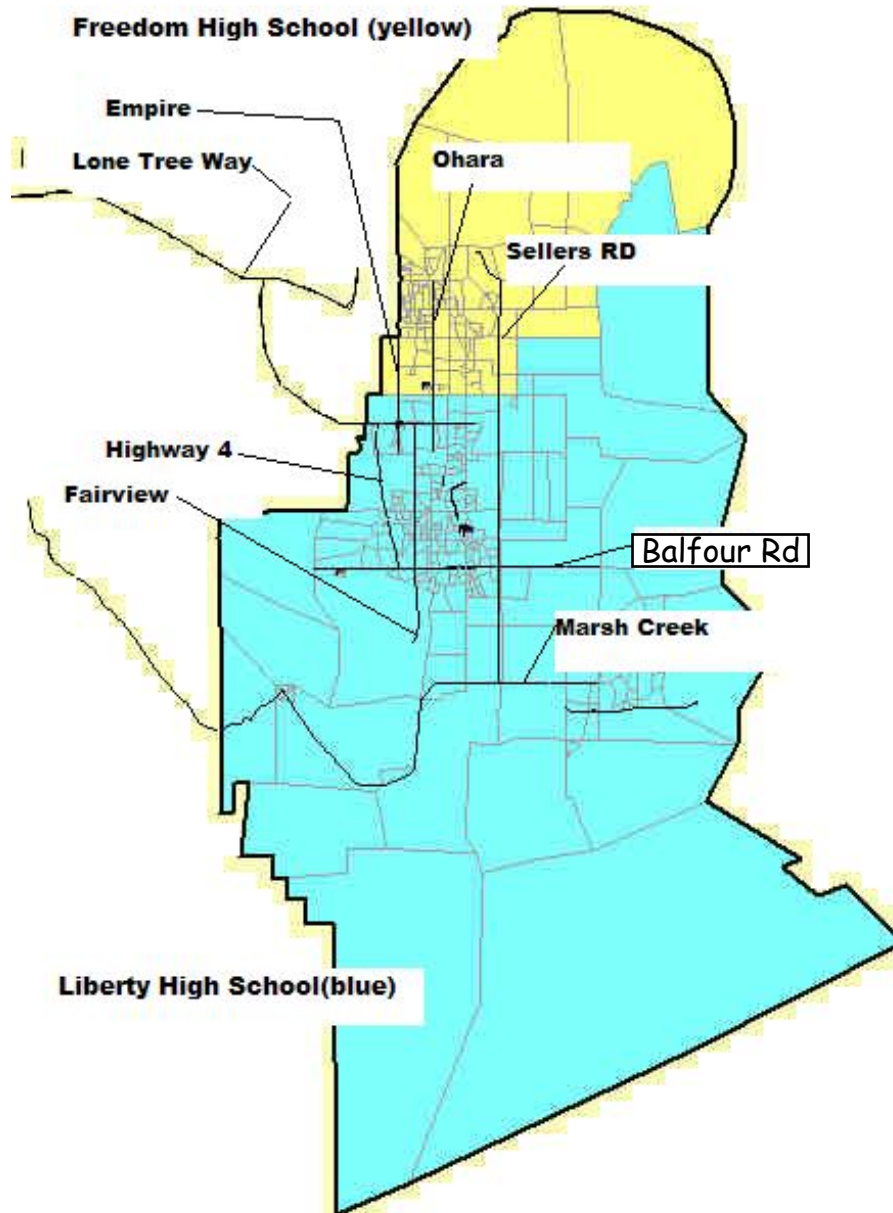
Board Parameters



- Achieve socioeconomic/ethnic balance
- Generate long term population balance for the three schools so they are equal in size when all four grade levels are present
- Minimize the number of students required to “drive by” one school to get to another



2003 base year map is shown below. The present year is called the Base year. All simulations start with the existing enrollment, schools and boundaries.



Heritage Option F3

High school projected enrollment under Option F3. Heritage High School is shown with 4 year (grades 9-12) enrollment.

The minority student counts and percentage in 2003-04 with boundary Option F are shown in the table below.
